5th Annual League Officer's & Team Captain's Tournament Rules

1. Any league officer, team captain, any officer or director of the Lancaster Women's 600 Club, Lancaster 700 Club or any officer or director of the Southeastern Ohio USBC, who is a member of the Southeastern Ohio USBC in good standing, is eligible to compete.
2. All USBC tournament rules will strictly prevail. This tournament is USBC CERTIFIED.
3. A bowler shall use their highest final SEOH USBC certified league average of the previous winter season (2009-10) in which they have bowled twenty-one (21) games or more. If no winter average, a bowler may use their highest SEOH USBC certified (2010) summer league average of 21 games or more or may use their highest USBC or Collegiate Division certified current season average based on twelve (12) or more games bowled at the time of the tournament. If no average, entrant will bowl scratch.
4. Each bowler is responsible for reporting their correct average (USBC Rule 319a3). Failure to use the correct average may disqualify entry if submitted average is lower than the correct average thereby resulting in a higher handicap. Prize winnings shall be based on the submitted average if it is higher than the correct average. However, corrections in average will be permitted up to the completion of the first game of the tournament series.
5. Three (3) games will comprise the number of games each entrant will bowl with their total score to include handicap computed at 95% of 225 scratch.
6. Any player arriving late shall begin play and the score shall count beginning in the frame bowled at that time. A zero will be scored for missed frames.
7. In case of a tie for first place, co-champions will be declared.
8. USBC rule 319d will not apply. (Reporting of prize winnings). Rule 319a2 and Rule 319e will not apply (Reporting an increase in average.).
9. Walk-ins welcome if lanes are available and entrants must be checked in 45 minutes prior to squad start. An additional \$5 processing fee must be paid.
10. 1st place will receive at least \$30.00 and a paid reservation to the Spring Banquet. Prize fund will be paid at 1 least out of 8 entries. Prize fund will be returned 100%.
